

Course Description

The Trauma Certified Registered Nurse (TCRN) Exam is a certification exam designed for nurses who seek board certification in trauma nursing. This educational program contains topics that are found on the TCRN Exam outline and is meant to increase the learners knowledge in trauma nursing in preparation to successfully pass the TCRN Exam.

Key Learning Outcome

- After completing the program, 80% of participants will report an increase in knowledge and confidence necessary to pass the certification exam.

Program Objectives

This program prepares the learner to:

- Be able to describe appropriate assessment techniques used to assess a patient with various traumatic injuries.
- Be able to describe appropriate interventions for commonly encountered traumatic injuries.
- Be able to describe common traumatic injuries encountered by trauma nurses.
- Be able to list common complications that may occur after a patient sustains traumatic injuries.
